Things for Spring

With the (mostly) mild Winter this year it might seem like we've been in the middle of Spring for a while, but according to the pesky calendar Spring is only just now beginning. The following tips will help keep your yard looking great.

- Put down pre-emergent early in the season. This keeps the warm season, annual grasses such as crabgrass from germinating.
- Set your mower to its highest setting.
 Cutting grass high helps keep out
 weeds and has the additional benefit of
 increasing drought tolerance. Mowing
 taller, but more frequently and
 fertilizing a couple times a year will
 result in a thicker and healthier lawn.
- Letting your grass clippings go back into the yard is the best thing for it.
 With this in mind, please make sure clippings are cleared from the street, sidewalks, and drains.

Friendly Reminders

- Residents with cement drains in your back yard It is your responsibility to keep drains clear of debris (grass clippings, leaves, paper, or anything that is not water). Yard waste in the basin causes draining issues and costs the HOA (you) money to have it cleaned. According to MSD anyone found putting debris in the basin/drain is subject to a \$1000 fine.
- We all love our pets, but what we don't love is pet waste being left out in yards and common areas. Please pick up after your pets and do not leave waste bags out anywhere other than your garbage can.
- Please remember that according to the FSN deed restrictions garbage cans must not be visible from the street.
- Boats are not allowed on driveways and may not be visible from the street. If notified of any issues homeowners will have 24 hours to move their boats.
- Yard signs are not allowed in the neighborhood with the exception of realty for sale signs on the property.

Spring Property Upkeep

Please make an effort to keep homes looking as new as possible. This includes things such as paint, gutters, bushes, and plants. If you received a deeds violation notice in the fall for work to be done this Spring, please make sure it is completed.
