What are dues used for?

We are often asked what the annual HOA dues are used for. In general, they are used for keeping up the appearance of the neighborhood and maintaining common areas.

The largest budget items are:

- Trash Pick-up/Waste Disposal -your dues pay for the weekly curbside trash pick-up.
- Common Area Maintenance/ Mowing -regular mowing and maintenance of the common areas around the neighborhood.
- Utilities power for the street lights throughout the neighborhood.
- Snow Removal/Road Salting-the snow removal/salting of roads when necessary in the Winter.
